- The lesson number at the far right of each entry shows where a word was first introduced to allow you to go back to the lesson and refresh your memory about the context in which it was used.

This cumulative glossary will be helpful in reviewing course vocabulary. It will also be a good tool to use for translation and transcription tasks you will be assigned. Keep in mind that many words listed here have additional meanings; this book is only course-related. For additional help, consult a commercial dictionary or ask your teacher.
